MASS INTENTIONS

In a typical week, Mass is celebrated at Corpus Christi on seven occasions. According to Church Law, one of the weekend Masses should be offered by the Parish Priest for the intentions of all the members of the community. This means that six Masses each week can be offered for other intentions – for those who have died or for the intentions of the living. These Masses are often heavily booked up so, if you want to arrange a Mass for a specific date, it is advisable to do so well in advance (months rather than weeks) to avoid disappointment.
